We got to control the fire hose extended from the fire engine testing the water on an open space I found it astonishing to ride in the fire engine across the site to refill the water tank using a reservoir near the entrance. 





This year in live entertainment, pop and country music superstar Taylor Swift is currently on her Eras Tour which is currently the highest grossing concert tour ever. It is one of the most ambitious, sophisticated tours that Taylor has performed since her Reputation Stadium tour which started in 2017. Each audience member gets to use a special wristband with LED lights and together they can create a starry environment in any stadium. The stage enhances the experience. The show itself is designed to be seen from all



directions and all angles, so there are no bad seats in any part of the venue, and I hope at the Liverpool concert we won't have a blind spot in the stadium.

Taylor likes to be inclusive to everyone that no matter where they are in the venue, they all get the best experience! She is always kind to people who are new to her music, and she even invites superfans to meet her and her family for a special occasion.


